The following Resolution was read:

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RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Clerk, pursuant to a Resolution duly passed and approved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls of the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1945, advertised, as provided by law, the following described real property for sale at public auction, to wit:

Lot Twenty-one (21) in Block One (1) of the Original Town Site of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and

WHEREAS, Fritz Johnson did offer and bid therefore the sum of Five Hundred dollars, (\$500.00), which said sum was the highest sum offered and the best bid made for said land, being the full appraised value thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the said bid of Fritz Johnson for said land in the amount of \$500.00 be, and the same hereby is accepted and approved and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a Deed to said land to said Fritz Johnson for and in behalf and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, conveying to said Fritz Johnson all the right, title and interest of the City of Idaho Falls in and to said land.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Letters from L. E. Stalker, Building Inspector and L. G. Jackson, Fire Chief reporting on their inspection of the Berry & Ball, and the Lambrecht Buildings on the corner of Park Avenue and Broadway were read.

A letter from Rueben C. Smith requesting permission from the City for space at the Municipal Airport to construct office and hangar was read. No action was taken on the request by the Mayor and City Council.

E. S. Trask and Ferrell Hansen appeared before the City Council, and requested the City to consider the purchase and installation of a City Public Scales, also a letter was read from the Garrett Freight lines. After considerable discussion no action was taken by the City Council.

The following letter was read:

Honorable Mayor and City Council  
Idaho Falls, Idaho

Gentlemen:

I understand that the City has title to certain property, which at present is not used, and which it is not now and will not, be necessary for the purposes of the City. I, therefore, make this request to this Honorably Body, that the said property be offered for sale in a manner consistent with the disposal of such property by a municipality.

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The property referred to is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Section line North 89° 48' East along the Section line 2010 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 37 East Boise Meridian, said beginning point also being the intersection point of the South line of said Section 12 with the East side of the County Road; thence North 89° 48' East along the Section line 200 feet; thence North 25° 32' West 657.7 feet; thence South 80° 0' East along the East side of County Road 600 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.37 acres, more or less, being part of Lot 5, or Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (SE¼ SW¼) of said Section 12.
