

AUGUST 17, 1945

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 17, 1945.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Absent: Sutton; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

Agreement with Western Union covering attachments on four City owned poles was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Absent: Sutton; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

Dear Mayor Fanning:

The Post Office has sent out a notice that every house should be correctly numbered. On Blaine Avenue between Crowley and Anderson Street in Block 32, every number is wrong. Every time we try to get it correct we get a different number. We, the undersigned signers, wish that someone, who has the authority and knows how, will have this corrected.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Meeting adjourned.
