Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 15<sup>th</sup>, 1945, and recessed until June 25<sup>th</sup>, 1945.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

The following Resolution was read:

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February, 1943, recorded in Book 45 of Deeds at Page 339, records of Bonneville County, and by Deed of the City Treasurer dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1945, recorded in Book 49 of Deeds at Page 415, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of

Lots Twenty-three (23) and Twenty-four (24) in Block Twenty one (21) of South Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, STERLING W. JENSEN has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum paid by said purchaser to make, execute and deliver to the said STERLING W. JENSEN for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

As per notice to contractors published June 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, and 24<sup>th</sup>, 1945, the following bids were received and opened: W. C. Burns: Total bid, \$15,833.60; Nic Burggraf: Total bid, \$15,343.60.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the bid submitted by Nic Burggraf for \$15,343.60 be accepted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Meeting was adjourned.

Passed and approved this 6<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1945.
