Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 18<sup>th</sup>, 1945, and recessed until May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1945.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Budget Estimate for the Fiscal Year 1945-1946 was presented and read to the City Council as follows:

**BUDGET ESTIMATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1945-1946**

The following is an estimate of the amount of money necessary for all purposes to be raised by taxation or otherwise in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, during the Fiscal Year 1945-1946, for which an appropriation is to be made as provided by law; said money to be apportioned for the purpose of paying indebtedness now existing and to accrue against the various funds of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, as follows, to wit:
