Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held April 20<sup>th</sup>, 1945.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

A committee representing the YMCA appeared before the City Council and requested the City to donate \$6,000 per year to help pay the cost of a YMCA program. After considerable discussion, no action was taken by the Mayor and City Council.

Agreement covering water connection on east end of Eleventh Street signed by William Funk, Herman Handy, and Berkley Christensen was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Quit claim deed covering the west 10 feet of Lot 4, and all of Lot 5, and the east 15 feet of Lot 6, in Block 2 of Anderson's Subdivision of Block 77 of the Original Town of Eagle Rock, excepting from above 20 feet off the northerly end of said Lots to Joseph G. Call was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the quit claim deed. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1944, recorded in Book 49 of Deeds at Page 50, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of the North half of Lots 1 to 4, both inclusive, in Block 15 of South Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, A. R. HUMMEL has offered to pay the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said A. R. HUMMEL for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following letter was read:

The Livestock Association requests \$200 from the City to be used to advertise the fat livestock show. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that \$200 be allowed to advertise the fat livestock show. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign a lease for the location of a prisoner of war camp on City property. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None. The Meeting was adjourned.

Passed and approved this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1945.
