Gentlemen:

The Bonneville Veterans Service Committee, set up under the Veterans Administration to assist returning Veterans under the G-I Law, finds it necessary to maintain a centrally located office with a competent person in charge. Unfortunately, the Federal law makes no provisions for maintaining such an office.

The local Service Committee is therefore under the necessity of requesting aid from the County and City. We believe that suitable office space can be secured without cost, but necessary equipment and a competent secretary will cost at least \$3000 a year. Veterans are being returned to civilian life in increasingly greater numbers. The number will increase, probably reaching its peak shortly after the close of the war and gradually decreasing in the two or three years after the war. We foresee the necessity of maintaining this agency for three or four years, depending on the length of the war. The nature of the contemplated service is shown in the attached plan of organization.

We respectfully ask that the County and City contribute \$1500 each to this project, the service to be started as soon as funds are made available.
