The following Resolutions were read:

"WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1942, recorded in Book 44, of Deeds at Page 645, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of Lots 33 and 34 in Block 21 of South Park Addition to the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, R. JENNINGS SCOTT, has offered to pay the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said R. JENNINGS SCOTT for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated."

"WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1944, recorded in Book 49 of Deeds, at Page 54, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lots 33 and 34 in

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Block 21 of South Park Addition to the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, R. JENNINGS SCOTT has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said R. JENNINGS SCOTT for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated."

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolutions be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
