There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; when the following proceedings were had, to wit:

The Zoning map presented, shows Blocks 9, 14, and 17 from Basalt Street to Short Street between Oneida and Chamberlain Avenues in the industrial zone.

Joseph Brandl, John T. Wing and other residents of this section entered a protest and they want these three Blocks taken out of the industrial zone, and put in the Class 'B' residence zone. The matter was taken under advisement by the Mayor and City Council.
