RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by Deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated this 15th day of February, 1944, recorded in Book 49 of Deeds at Page 46, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of Lots 1 and 2 in Block 12 of South Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, ARDETH WILLIAMS has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of the said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said ARDETH WILLIAMS, for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a Deed to the said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 49-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.
