It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for building permit No. 3189 signed by Animal By Products Co. was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the permit be held up for investigation. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1944-1945 AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading.

Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by JUNE 7, 1944

Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 570 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 21st day of June, 1944.
