It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Treasurer be authorized to purchase \$50,000.00 worth of Series C Government Bonds. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the City donate \$100.00 to the Idaho Falls Fat Livestock Show. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor notify the owners of sign boards on the end of First Street and Boulevard to move their sign boards off City property as the City wants to plant some trees and beautify the approach to the subway. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.
