

DECEMBER 7, 1943

Mayor of Idaho Falls and

Idaho Falls, Idaho

Gentlemen:

During the 1943 summer recreation program Ellis McAllister was employed as swim director. He attended the Red Cross Water Safety at Como Springs, Utah, a year ago last summer. The Pacific Area Red Cross officials were eager for him to attend again last summer in order to qualify under Red Cross regulations. He had held the Red Cross credentials prior to his work in Idaho Falls. As you are aware, instructors are required to take special work at intervals in order to keep their credentials in effect.

Mr. McAllister did not feel he could attend during the past summer unless paid for the loss of time. After consulting with local Red Cross officials and executive committee of the recreation council, Mr. McAllister was authorized to attend the summer session with the assurance that he would be reimbursed for the loss of time.

In budgeting the recreation expenditures, this item was not foreseen. For that reason Mr. McAllister has not been reimbursed because of lack of funds in the recreation budget. Since funds will not be available until next year, we wonder if the City Council might be induced to meet this obligation to Mr. McAllister. As director of the summer recreation program, I shall be glad to have the City's obligation for summer recreation in 1944 reduced by that amount if so desire .

If further information concerning this bill is required, I shall be glad to meet with the Council.
