

JUNE 8, 1943

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho held June 4th, 1943, and recessed until June 8th, 1943.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; when the following proceedings were had to wit.

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Waterworks Superintendent, Street & Park Commissioner, Sanitary & Meat Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, School & City Nurse.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1943-1944, AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings, be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 565 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official paper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The Finance Committee presented the following list of claims covering bills for the month of May, 1943, in the sum of \$31,284.08, which had been checked by the Purchasing Agent and approved by them, and they recommend that the same be allowed.

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 1st day of February, 1943, recorded in 45 of Deeds at Page 341, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of Lots 39 to 40 in Block 19, of South Park Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and

WHEREAS, J. E. WHITAKER has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 27th day of January, 1943, recorded in Book 45 of Deeds at Page 3, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lots 3 and 4 in Block 90 Riverside Addition to the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the bids be called for the seal coat special paving districts numbers 17 and 18 and resurface Elm Street. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.
