An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE WORD "FUMIGATION"; PROVIDING FOR THE EXAMINATION AND LICENSING OF FUMIGATORS; REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR FUMIGATION; CREATING A BOARD OF FUMIGATION AND VESTING SAID BOARD WITH THE POWER TO PRESCRIBE RULES AND REGULATIONS COVERING FUMIGATION IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF SAID FUMIGATION BOARD," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. The Ordinance was then numbered 564, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed, and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.
