Mayor E. W. Fanning and City Councilman Thomas L. Sutton took the Official Oath of office and were sworn in by the City Clerk.

Agreement covering the purchase of water for the Union Pacific Railroad Co. was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: none; Absent: Freeman; motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE WORD "FUMIGATION"; PROVIDING FOR THE EXAMINATION AND LICENSING OF FUMIGATORS; REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR FUMIGATION; CREATING A BOARD OF FUMIGATION AND VESTING SAID BOARD WITH THE POWER TO PRESCRIBE RULES AND REGULATIONS COVERING FUMIGATION IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF SAID FUMIGATION BOARD" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: none; Absent: Freeman; motion carried.

An Agreement between the City of Idaho Falls and Ronald C. Hammond covering the operation of motor boats on the fore bay of Snake River was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Sutton; Nay: none; Absent: Freeman; motion carried.

Councilman Crabtree nominated Councilman Sutton for President of the City Council, and Councilman Wasley seconded the nomination. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the election of Councilman Sutton as President of the City Council be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Mayor Fanning; Nay: none; Absent: Freeman; motion carried.

The Mayor appointed W. A. Baker as President of the Library Board. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the appointment be confirmed. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: none; Absent: Freeman; motion carried.
