TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR & CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned pioneers of Snake River Valley, who knew the valley as—"The Snake River Desert" and Eagle Rock was our post office, respectfully beg that you change the name of the City Park back to the original name of Tautphaus Park.
