Grave Space for infant	5.00

All lots of portions thereof shall be sold for cash and all sexton's fees shall be collected cash in advance before work is done.

The City Clerk is authorized and directed to collect for the sale of lots and for sexton's fees according to the above schedule of charges from the date of passage of this Resolution.
