Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held February 19th, 1943.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for licenses were read:

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried.

The following Resolutions were read:

WHEREAS, BONNEVILLE COUNTY has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the salary of the Mayor for the term beginning May 1st, 1943 be 3,600.00 per annum. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

FEBRUARY 19, 1943

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND REGULATING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE TERM BEGINNING MAY 1, 1943, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 563, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widows allowance on water and light account signed by Mrs. Adeline Topham was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

Harry J. Hemler requested that the City put up for sale a small piece of a lot which adjoins his property on the north highway. The Mayor referred the petition to the Street & Park Committee, and the City Engineer.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.
