Application for building permit No. 2999 signed by Angus Miles was read. It moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the permit be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Meter Deposit Interest Fund which shows a balance of \$16.53 be transferred to the General Fund and Bonds Number 15 and 16 of Improvement District No. 16 for \$912.06 be paid out of the General Fund to the Clerk's Trust Account as per audit report dated October 31<sup>st</sup>, 1942. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

Notice of election of Water Master for District No. 36 to be held March 1<sup>st</sup>, 1943 in the District Courtroom at Idaho Falls was read. The Mayor appointed the City Attorney to represent the City at the Meeting.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Treasurer be authorized to purchase \$10,000.00 worth of Series G Government Bonds out of the Meter Deposit Account. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.
