An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NO. 2 OF ORDINANCES NO. 518 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS RELATING TO, AND PROVIDING FOR A SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATED AND SOLD BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR COMMERCIAL USE; AND AMENDING SECTION NO. 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 518 RELATING TO, AND PROVIDING FOR A RATE AND CHARGE FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATED AND SOLD BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR DOMESTIC USE: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at the separate Meetings, be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 562, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widows allowance on water and light account signed by Mrs. Lena Poynter was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.
