The Mayor recommends that the resignation of Mrs. Adeline Topham as Ladies restroom matron be accepted, and the Mayor appointed Mrs. Anna Gould as Ladies restroom matron. It was

moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the resignation and appointment be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

The Mayor recommends that the City purchase a \$5000.00 Government Bond. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Treasurer be authorized to purchase a \$5,000.00 Government Bond. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree that the Mayor be authorized to sign all necessary papers with the Insurance Companies, to obtain a settlement for the loss of fire of the caretaker's house at the lower power plant on November 17, 1942. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried.
