Application for widows allowance on water and light account signed by Mrs. William Klossner was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

The Mayor recommends that the City purchase from Fred Guderjohn his gravel loader and screens for \$1,000.00. The loader and screens are to be used at the City's gravel pit south of the City. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to purchase the gravel loader and screens for \$1,000.00. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

The Mayor stated that the Smith house on the corner of Mound Avenue and Elva Street can be rented for the Nursery School. The expense for the winter to run the school would be \$275.00. The Community Chest will pay \$150.00 and they request the City to pay \$125.00. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the City pay \$125.00 to cover their share of the expense to operate the Nursery School.
