Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 18<sup>th</sup>, 1942.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman. When the following proceedings were had to wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read:

No. 2973 signed by Nellie Bate

No. 2974 signed by Hy Dutton

No. 2975 signed by Carl Schmidt

No. 2977 signed by A. E. Stanger

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

Agreement between the Bingham County Farmers Mutual Insurance Co. and the City of Idaho Falls covering the operation and storage of their fire truck was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried.

Agreement between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the City of Idaho Falls covering pole storage site was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the Agreement. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

An ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR, AND FIXING THE TAX LEVY OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR ALL PURPOSES, INCLUDING THE GENERAL FUND AND THE MUNICIPAL LIBRARY FUND" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried.

The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

The Ordinance was numbered 560 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the City Treasurer be authorized to purchase a \$1,000.00 war bond and the money to be taken out of the customers meter deposit account. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn; motion carried.
