The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 27th day of January, 1942, and recorded in Book 44 of Deeds, at Page 641, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of all to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, Frances Chriswell, a widow, has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls, the amount for which the property was sold to the City together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said FRANCES CHRISWELL, a widow, for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property, pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Code Annotated.
