

JUNE 29TH, 1942

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 19th, 1942, and recessed until June 29th, 1942.

RESOLUTION

"WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 27th day of January, 1942, recorded in Book 44, of Deeds at Page 608, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lot 42, of Block 3, of Crow's Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, LOVEDA PETERSEN, a married woman, has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls, the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase one 1942 Hudson Sedan from Elswood Motor Company for \$1040.00 for the Police Department. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.
