Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 5th, 1942.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49 Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 27th day of January, 1942, recorded in Book 44 of Deeds at Page 597, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of all of Lots 47 and 48, in Block 54, of Crow's Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, H. F. Greenhalgh has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereof:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum of said purchaser, to make, execute, and deliver to the said H. F. Greenhalgh for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 20-2551 Idaho Code Annotated."

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, hereby petition the City of Idaho Falls, for water service on the west side of the Snake River.

We agree to dig our trench, and furnish the pipe which will run the water service to our homes.

We also agree to pay the regular curb connection for $\frac{3}{4}$ inch connection \$4.50 for each connection.

The Mayor recommended that the City purchase 25 acres of land located east of the City Park from the H. H. Plank Estate for \$7500.00 It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the

Mayor and City Attorney be authorized to purchase the 25 acres of land from the H. H. Plank Estate for \$7500.00 Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

JUNE 5TH, 1942

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Mayor be authorized to purchase or condemn three pieces of property on Memorial Drive owned by Julius Ehlers, Mrs. Rhoda Price and Mrs. Sabra A. Roberts to complete the River Drive from Memorial Drive to John's Hole Bridge. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried.
