

MAY 15th, 1942

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held May 15th, 1942.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Wasley. When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

F. W. Gourley of the Soft Water Service Co. appeared before the Council and requested permission to install a gas baking tank in their basement stairway at 430 B Street to bake inside of tanks. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that a special permit be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

The following applications for building permits were read:

No. 2939 signed by Blind Bull Coal Co.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Absent: Wasley. Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1942-1943, AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILES OF THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Absent: Wasley. Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was once again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 558 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING SECTIONS 342,343,344 AND 346 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton; that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Nay: None; Absent: Wasley; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 559 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widow's allowance on Water and Light accounts, signed by Annie D. Stevens, was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Wasley; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase 2440 tons of rock chips at \$2.00 per ton to be used in repairing streets. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: Wasley; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase one Ford Truck Chassis from the Bonneville Auto Company for \$1358.00. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Freeman, Sutton; Absent: Wasley; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Freeman; Absent: Wasley; motion carried.
