

FEBRUARY 20, 1942

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held February 20th, 1942.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman. When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following license applications for Electrical Contractor licenses were read: Idaho Falls Electric Co. and Hisgen Electric. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the licenses be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Notice of election of a Water Master for 1942 in Water District No. 36 was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the City Attorney represent the City at the Annual Meeting to be held March 2nd, 1942. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following Cooperative Agreement was read:

**“COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
Between the State of Idaho
and City of Idaho Falls”**

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the State of Idaho, party of the first part, hereinafter called the “State” and the City of Idaho Falls, a Municipal corporation, party of the second part, hereinafter called the “City”.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of July, 1940, the City adopted the following Resolution, to wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that said City of Idaho Falls will obtain, provide and furnish, at its own cost and expense, additional right of way for said U. S. Highway No. 191, commonly known as the Yellowstone Park Highway, on or before October 1, 1941; the following described real property for such highway purposes, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Westerly boundary of U. S. Highway #91, that is South 89 degrees 55' West 506.2 feet and South 29 degrees 15' West 412.0 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 37 East, Boise Meridian-said point being also 100.0 feet Westerly and at right angles to the center line of the O.S.L.R.R. right of way; and continuing thence South 29 degrees 15' West 735.0 feet, thence North 60 degrees 45' West 33.0 feet, thence North 29 degrees 15' East 738.6 feet, thence South 54 degrees 33' East 33.2 feet to the point of beginning; and that said property will be made available for such highway purposes by the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on or before October 1, 1941; and

WHEREAS, that thereafter it was ascertained that the cost of the said above described right of way and the cost of moving certain service stations and buildings situate thereon

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would be much in excess of the amount believed to be necessary at the date of the said Resolution; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Idaho Falls, has applied to the State for financial cooperation in connection with the obtaining of said right of way and the moving of said buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that the State will cooperate with the City in the matter of obtaining the said right of way and the removal of said buildings and service stations to the extent of \$3,000.00 That the City will bear all of the expense of every name and nature in obtaining the said right of way over and above the said sum of \$3,000.00.

The said \$3,000.00 will be paid by the State upon presentation of a claim by the City, when and if the City shall have paid all other costs and expenses in the matter of obtaining the said right of way.

IN WITNESSETH WHEREOF, The State has caused these presents to be executed by the Commissioner of Public Works on the 24th day of February, 1942, and the City has caused the same to be executed by its Mayor and attested by its City Clerk on the 20th day of February, 1942.

WHEREAS, H. E. Brown has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said H. E. Brown for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed upon payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said H. E. Brown, for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 27th day of January, 1942, recorded in Book 44 of Deeds at Page 587, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title and possession of Lots 41 and 44, inclusive, in Block 9 of Crow's Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

Edwards, for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated."

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49 Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 21st day of December, 1939, recorded in Book 39 of Deeds at Page 600, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to and possession of Lot Forty (40) Block Forty-seven (47) Crow's Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

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WHEREAS, Ruth Bybee has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by purchaser, to make, execute and deliver to the said Ruth Bybee, for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolutions be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF A TAXICAB LICENSE UNLESS THE OWNER SHALL HAVE FIRST FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK AN INSURANCE POLICY OR SURETY BOND PROTECTING THE PUBLIC AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE FROM THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS, AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A TAXICAB WITHOUT HAVING ON FILE SUCH POLICY OF INSURANCE OR BOND AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The following applications for widows allowance on water and light accounts were read: Mildred Ruiz and Irene Donaldson. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor recommended that George O'Rullian be employed as professional at the golf course for the year 1942, on the same terms as in 1941. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the recommendation of the Mayor be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
