RESOLUTION

Re: Idaho Application 15079  
City Park Grandstand  
Bonneville County

Be It Resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Idaho Falls, Idaho:

That the new grandstand at the City Park in Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, upon completion, will be maintained, operated, and controlled by the City of Idaho Falls, for the use of the general public and that such use will not be restricted to any particular group or organization.

That the City Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to send to the Federal Works Agency, Work Projects Administration, three certified copies of the proceedings of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, in connection with the adoption of this Resolution."

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF A TAXICAB LICENSE UNLESS OWNER SHALL HAVE FIRST FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK AN INSURANCE POLICY OR SURETY BOND PROTECTING THE PUBLIC AGAINST LOSS OR DAMAGE FROM THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A TAXICAB WITHOUT HAVING ON FILE SUCH POLICY OF INSURANCE OR BOND AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.
