It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, and Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 556 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was, by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
