An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NO. 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 518 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS RELATING TO, AND PROVIDING FOR A SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATED AND SOLD BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR COMMERCIAL USE; AND AMENDING SECTION NO. 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 518 RELATING TO, AND PROVIDING FOR A RATE AND CHARGE FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATED AND SOLD BY THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR DOMESTIC USE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE." was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled, "AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING AND CLOSING EMERSON AVENUE BETWEEN COLLEGE AND ELVA STREETS IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 561, and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was, by him, the Mayor duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following widows applications for allowance on water and light accounts were read: Mrs. Effie Peasley and Mrs. Josie E. Smith. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; motion carried.
