

JANUARY 7, 1942

Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 2nd, 1942 and recessed until January 7th, 1942.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Lease Nos. 9289 and 8952 with the Union Pacific Railroad Co. were read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease agreements. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor recommended that the City Beer License Tax be raised from \$7.50 to \$25.00 per year. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the recommendation of the Mayor be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 468 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO: AND FIXING THE LICENSE TAX ON RETAILERS OF BEER IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

OF BEER IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Freeman, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 554 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 464 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: PROVIDING FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR'S LICENSES: FIXING THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE OF AN ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR: REQUIRING A SURETY BOND FROM AN ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS AND PROVIDING THE CONDITIONS THEREOF", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Wasley, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 555 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following Resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated the 1st day of February 1941, recorded in Book 44 of Deeds at Page 309, Records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title and possession of Lots 6 and 7 in Block 9 of Crow's Addition to the Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, according to the recorded plat thereof; and

WHEREAS, Louise Rapp has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments

subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereof:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

JANUARY 7, 1942

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser to make, execute and deliver to the said Louise Rapp for, and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated".

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that Ernest Lake's salary be increased from \$35.00 to \$50.00 a month, during the next winter months as recommended by Dr. J. S. Allen. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 16th day of January, 1942.
