Minutes of a regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held December 19<sup>th</sup>, 1941.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last regular Meeting were read and approved.

The following applications for building permits were read:

- No. 2896 signed by P. A. Smith
- No. 2897 signed by D. F. Maurer
- No. 2898 signed by Milous Morse

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

George Brunt appeared before the City Council, and suggested that the Mayor call a meeting of all the Mayors of cities from Pocatello north to meet in Idaho Falls and form a Planning Board to promote and develop the natural resources of this section of Idaho. Mr. Brunt stated that the Chamber of Commerce have failed to do anything to have the Governor locate any defense projects in this section. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Mayor call a meeting of the Mayors of all cities from Pocatello to Ashton to meet in Idaho Falls to discuss or organize a Southeastern Idaho Planning Board to develop the resources of this section of the State, and obtain government aid or promote location of government defense projects in Southeastern Idaho. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Applications for widow's allowance on water and light account signed by Emily Cazier was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the City Treasurer be authorized to transfer \$329.20 from the Bond Interest Fund to the Bond Sinking Fund. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.
