

SEPTEMBER 23, 1941

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held September 19th, 1941, and recessed until September 23rd, 1941.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Absent, None. When the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read and approved.

Application for building permit No. 2812 signed by Ray Groth for the Standard Oil Company of California to remodel the grocery store and service station on the corner of 13th Street and Holmes Avenue was read. Several property owners appeared before the Council and made protests against the improvement. Also, the owners of the property presented their side of the case. After considerable discussion, the Mayor referred the building permit to the Building Committee and the City Engineer to investigate the petitions, and the property owners who signed the petitions to see if they live within three hundred feet of the store and service station.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the City cooperate with the State of Idaho and close parking on Cottage Avenue from Cliff Street to D Street on the west side, and from Broadway to D Street on the east side. Parking regulations to be effective as soon as the State erects the no parking signs. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton and seconded by Freeman, that the City rent the Reed garage on the North Highway to store City trucks and street equipment in, at a rental of \$150.00 per month. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the new street flusher be purchased through the Eastside Lumber Company for \$4,800.00, and to be paid for on a rental basis of \$225.00 per month. The rent paid each month is to be applied on the purchase price. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
