Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held August 15th, 1941.

Gentlemen:

Herewith is an estimate for pumping equipment for the well at the Lower Power Plant.

The 5 horsepower, 220 volt, 3 phase motor; 315 gallon galvanized pressure tank; 1960 A. M. 12 inch stroke Myers Pump; 150 feet of 3 1/2 inch galvanized well pipe; 150 feet of wood rod; 3/4 X 53 1/2 double action cylinder, magnetic switch, entrance switch together with all fittings to make complete water system installed in the well except the wiring.

Net \$599.85; credit on old equipment with exception of pipe, \$83. 25; leaving a net price of \$516.60.
