“WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated December 21st, A. D. 1938, recorded in Book 44 of Deeds at Page AUGUST 8, 1941

302, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of the West Seventeen feet (17') of Lot Twelve (12) and all of Lot Thirteen (13) in Block Fifty-four (54) of Crow's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, J. L. Grimmatt has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereon;

“WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49 Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated December 21st, A.D. 1938, recorded in Book 44 of Deeds, at Page 304, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title to, and possession of Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block Fifty (50) of Crow's Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,
