An Ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING IDAHO FALLS MOTOR COACH CO. INC., A CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, AN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING PASSENGER BUSES: REQUIRING THE FILING OF ROUTE SCHEDULES WITH THE CITY CLERK: PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM FARE TO BE CHARGED: PROVIDING FOR THE CLASS OF SERVICE TO BE GIVEN: PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE: PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF SUITABLE PARKING PLACES: PROVIDING PAYMENT OF A PERCENTAGE OF THE GROSS INCOME TO THE CITY: AND FOR GENERAL REGULATIONS OF SAID BUSES BY THE CITY COUNCIL," was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried. It was moved by Freeman, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate Meetings be suspended, and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Crabtree, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Freeman, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Voting Nay: None; Motion carried. The Ordinance was then numbered 552 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Application for widow's allowance on water and light account signed by Mrs. Barbara Rushton was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
