It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

At this time an Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF 20TH STREET, LYING AND BEING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF WHAT IS NOW KNOWN AS LOT TWENTY-THREE OF BREMER HOMES ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, BEING A SUB-DIVISION OF ALL OF BLOCK THIRTY-ONE AND LOTS TWENTY-NINE TO FORTY-EIGHT, BOTH INCLUSIVE, OF BLOCK TWENTY-FOUR OF THE SOUTH PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE USE OF ALTON J. ANDERSON AND NORMA B. ANDERSON, THEIR SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS." was brought before the Council for its consideration, and, it appearing to the Mayor and Council that there is an urgency existing for the passage of the above entitled Ordinance. After due consideration of said matter, it was moved by Councilman Crabtree, seconded by Councilman Wasley, that the rules be suspended and that the said Ordinance be read at length three times and that roll call be taken on said matter after each reading, whereupon the Mayor directed the Clerk to call the roll. Voting Aye: Councilmen Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None. Thereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the rules suspended and directed the Clerk to read said Ordinance at length. After the reading of said Ordinance it was moved by Councilman Sutton, seconded by Councilmen Freeman, that said Ordinance pass its first reading. Voting Aye: Councilmen Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the Ordinance passed its first reading. The Mayor then directed the Clerk to read the Ordinance in full the second time and after said reading it was moved by Councilman Freeman, seconded by Sutton, that said Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Voting Aye: Councilmen Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None. Thereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and that said Ordinance had passed its second reading and directed the Clerk to read said Ordinance in full for the third time and after the reading thereof it was moved by Councilman Sutton, seconded by Councilmen Crabtree, that said Ordinance be declared passed and that the same be adopted and approved, and after being properly signed and numbered it shall be duly published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho. Voting Aye: Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the Ordinance duly passed and approved.

The Mayor then signed said Ordinance and it was duly numbered 551.

The following letter was read:

Idaho Falls, Idaho
July 6, 1941

Honorable Mayor and City Council
City of Idaho Falls

Gentlemen:

I recommend that you have the fire hydrant on the corner of Canal Avenue and J Street moved closer to the curb as we are unable to reach same without driving onto the sidewalk. I

also recommend that you move the hydrant located on the corner of First Street and Boulevard to the southwest corner of First Street and Boulevard as this hydrant sits on the wrong side of

the highway. I also recommend at this time that you place an order for one thousand feet of two and one-half inch hose in order to take advantage of the price advance which will take effect the sixteenth of July.

We, the undersigned residents of the City of Idaho Falls, and patrons of the Eastside School, hereby petition the Honorable Mayor and City Council to use all their influence consistent with good business, to the end that Fourteenth Street be paved from Emerson Avenue to Higbee Avenue, thereby affording proper approach to the Eastside School and school grounds.”

The Mayor referred the petition to the Street Committee, which will have it included in the first paving district to be created this fall.

Application for widow’s allowance on light and water account, signed by Mary E. Stewart, was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the regular allowance be granted. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
