

JUNE 26, 1941

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 20th, 1941 and recessed until June 24th, 1941 and again recessed until June 26th, 1941.

There were present at said Meeting: E. W. Fanning, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had to-wit:

The following applications for Building Permits were read:

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the Permits be approved. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Application for Building Permit No. 2721 signed by E. L. Tracy was read. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Wasley, that the Permit be rejected and not approved until the house is connected with sewer. Roll call voting Aye: Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley; Nay: None; Motion carried.

Contract with the Union Pacific Railroad Company covering power transmission line crossing near airport was read. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Sutton, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the contract. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase pipe fittings which will cost about nine hundred dollars. Roll call voting Aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman; Nay: None; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to purchase fourteen Sam Brown police belts, and fourteen police caps, with the approval of the Civil Service Commission. Roll call voting Aye: Wasley, Freeman, Sutton, Crabtree; Nay: None; Motion carried.

The Mayor appointed the following Committee to meet with the owners of the bus franchise: Councilmen Thomas L. Sutton, and R. A. Freeman.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Freeman, that the Meeting adjourn. Roll call voting Aye: Crabtree, Wasley, Freeman, Sutton; Nay: None; Motion carried.
