**RESOLUTION**

“WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 25, Article 49, Idaho Code Annotated, and by deed of the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, dated December 21, 1938, recorded in Book 4 of Deeds at page 307, records of Bonneville County, Idaho, acquire title and possession of Lots 11, 12 and 13, in Block 10, of Crow’s Addition to the Original Town of Eagle Rock, now the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, according to the recorded plat thereof; and,

WHEREAS, L. L. Hayden has offered to pay to the City of Idaho Falls the amount for which the property was sold to the City, together with all installments of assessments subsequent to the one for which said property was sold and then due, together with penalties and interest thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed upon the payment of said sum by said purchaser, to make execute and deliver to the said L. L. Hayden for and in the name of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, a deed to said property pursuant to the provisions of Section 29-2551 Idaho Code Annotated.”
