A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Lee Walker, City Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, did, on the 18th day of February, 1941, duly certify to me that it had been ascertained by a census or enumeration taken under the laws of the United States of America, for the year 1940, that the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, has attached a population of over fifteen thousand inhabitants, and by reason thereof, is qualified to become a City of the first class;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Chase A. Clark, Governor of the State of Idaho, in accordance with requirements and provisions of Section 49-103 Idaho Code Annotated, do hereby proclaim and declare said City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, to be, and the same shall become, a City of the First Class and is entitled to any and all rights, privileges and benefits of a City of the First Class, from date hereof.
