An Ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND REGULATING THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR THE TERM BEGINNING MAY 1, 1941; FIXING THE TIME AT WHICH NEWLY ELECTED OFFICERS SHALL ASSUME THE DUTIES OF THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICES: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" was read in full by the Clerk. voting Aye, Brandl, Mooney, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton; Absent; Crabtree; Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the rule of law requiring that an Ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended and the Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call voting Aye, Sutton, Brandl, Mooney, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans; Motion carried.

The Ordinance was again read in full by the City Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mooney, that the Ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call voting Aye, Evans, Sutton, Brandl, Mooney, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley; Motion carried.

The Ordinance was again read in full by the City Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Brandl, that the Ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call voting Aye, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Brandl, Mooney, Gourley, Mehlhoff; Motion carried.

The Ordinance was then numbered 546 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

Petition for street lights at the corner of West 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Curtis Avenue, and at the corner of West 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Calkins Avenue, signed by John Shannon, and twenty-three other parties who reside on West 16<sup>th</sup> Street was read. The Mayor referred the petition to the Water and Light Committee.
