The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

“WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, in the State of Idaho, made application to the Department of Public Works of the State of Idaho, for permission to construct and maintain an 8-inch metal pipe line and 4-inch cast iron connecting pipe lines along and under the Idaho-Montana FAP 43 AB Highway and to attach a portion of said pipe line to the state bridge over Snake River in the County of Bonneville, State of Idaho; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works of the State of Idaho has submitted to said City of Idaho Falls an Agreement dated October 9, 1940, granting the right to construct such a pipe line as above described and at the above described location, and said City of Idaho Falls has submitted a print showing the place and manner of such installation, which said print is attached to said agreement and marked Exhibit “A”; and,

WHEREAS, it appears it would be to the best interests, benefit and advantage of said City of Idaho Falls that said Agreement be executed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE it resolved, that said Agreement and the location of said pipe lines as shown on said pring be, and the same are hereby accepted on the part of and by the said City of Idaho Falls and that the Mayor and Clerk of said City of Idaho Falls be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said Agreement in the name of and on behalf of said City of Idaho Falls and to affix thereto the seal of said City of Idaho Falls, and that when so executed the said Agreement shall in all respects be the Agreement of said City of Idaho Falls."

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Wasley, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Absent: Sutton and Gourley. Motion carried.

The following application for widows allowance on water and lights was read:
