It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the permits be approved, with the exception of Permit No. 2489, and this permit approved if the garage is set back four feet from the property line. An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SHOOT OR DISCHARGE FIREARMS IN THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Wasley, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley, Sutton. Absent: Mehlhoff, Evans. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its third reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley. Absent: Mehlhoff, Evans. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Wasley. Absent: Evans, Mehlhoff. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 545 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.
