The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, by its Mayor and City Council, on the 19<sup>th</sup> Day of April, 1940, passed and approved a resolution wherein and whereby the City of Idaho Falls agreed to obtain, furnish and provide, at its own cost and expense, a thirty-three (33) foot strip of additional right of way in the southerly part of the City of Idaho Falls for U. S. Highway No. 191, commonly known as the Yellowstone Park Highway; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Roads Administration is of the opinion that such resolution is not sufficiently definite or clear and that a new resolution should be passed and approved by the City of Idaho Falls;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that said City of Idaho Falls will obtain, provide and furnish, at its own cost and expense, additional right of way for said U. W. Highway No. 191, commonly known as the Yellowstone Park Highway, on or before October 1, 1941, the following described real property for such highway purposes, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the Westerly boundary of U. S. Highway #91 that is S. 89 degrees 55' W. 506.2 feet and S. 29 degrees 15' W. 412.0 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 25, Township 2 North, Range 37 East Boise Meridian, said point being also 100.0 feet Westerly and at right angles to the center line of the O.S.L.R.R. right of way; and continuing thence S. 29 degrees 15' W. 735.0 feet, thence N. 60 degrees 45' W. 33.0 feet, thence N.29 degrees 15' E. 738.6 feet, thence S.54 degrees 33' E.33.2 feet to the point of beginning;

and that said property will be made available for such highway purposes by the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on or before October 1, 1941."

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Crabtree, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Absent: Gourley and Wasley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Evans. Voting nay: None. Absent: Gourley and Wasley. Motion carried.
