GASOLINE THAT MAY BE STORED AT ONE LOCATION AND THE MAXIMUM CAPACITY OF STORAGE TANKS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Sutton, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Absent: Gourley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Crabtree, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Absent: Gourley. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Absent: Gourley. Motion carried.
