

JUNE 7, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held June 7th, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Absent: Crabtree. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, City Electrician, Water Works Supt., Street & Park Commissioner, Police Judge, Chief of Fire Department, School & City Nurse, Sanitary & Meat Inspector.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1940-1941 AND PROVIDING THE NUMBER OF MILLS ON THE DOLLAR APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OF SAID FUNDS", was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Absent: Crabtree. Motion carried.

It was moved by Evans, seconded by Brandl, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Absent: Crabtree. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Absent: Crabtree. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Absent: Crabtree. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 542 and passed to the Mayor for his approval and was, by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved, and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.
