

MARCH 1, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held March 1st, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit;

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

The following monthly reports were read and approved: City Clerk, Water Works Superintendent, Street Commissioner, Sanitary Inspector, Chief of Fire Department, School and City Nurse.

The following applications for building permits were read:

No. 2236 signed by Mrs. Frank Bird

No. 2238 signed by M. G. Carlson

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Fanning, that the permits be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

E. D. Vissing appeared before the council and requested the City to close the West end of Gladstone Street by his auto court. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance to close the street. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: DESCRIBING SAID LANDS, AND DECLARING THE SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Gourley, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and the Bus Franchise Ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled: AN ORDINANCE GRANTING WILLIAM J. VAIL IN EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO USE THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING PASSENGER BUSES: REQUIRING THE FILING OF ROUTE SCHEDULES WITH THE CITY CLERK: PROVIDING THE MAXIMUM FARE TO BE CHARGED: PROVIDING FOR THE CLASS OF SERVICE TO BE GIVEN: PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY

INSURANCE: PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF SUITABLE PARKING PLACES: PROVIDING PAYMENT OF A PERCENTAGE OF THE GROSS INCOME TO THE CITY: AND FOR GENERAL REGULATIONS OF SAID BUSES BY THE CITY COUNCIL:, was ready in full by the Clerk.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Crabtree, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading, and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 532 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, but was not approved by the Mayor.

It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Gourley, that the meeting recess until March 8th, 1940, at eight o'clock P.M. Roll call. Voting aye: Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

Passed and approved this 15th day of March, 1940.
