

JANUARY 19, 1940

Minutes of a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, held January 19th, 1940.

There were present at said meeting Chase A. Clark, Mayor; Lee Walker, City Clerk; Councilmen Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Absent: None. When the following proceedings were had, to wit:

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

The following Petitions signed by 413 residents were read:

“Hon. Mayor and Council
Idaho Falls, Idaho.

The undersigned being taxpayers and voters of the City of Idaho Falls, respectfully protest the effort being made to have your Honors make and for the removal of the C Street Parking and Trees. This street was designed as a beauty spot on which public buildings should face and also it represents the only distinctive feature which our city has to offer to visitors. It also represents a beauty spot for the enjoyment of all the people.”

“We the undersigned, protest the removal of the center parking of “C” Street and desire that an agreement be made to insure its continuance.”

“To the Honorable Mayor and City Council
Idaho Falls, Idaho.

After considerable discussion by W. L. Shattuck, David Smith, who represented the property owners on C Street who wanted the parking removed, and by Geo. B. Willsey, Mrs. H. D. Spencer, Alvin Denman, L. M. Earl, Mrs. Otto E. McCutcheon, C. R. Crowley, and Dr. B. M. Brookfield who wanted the parking left in, the Mayor advised the petitioners that the City Council had not taken any action of the matter, and when the final action would be taken by the City Council all parties interested would be advised through the Post-Register.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the permits be approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

The following resolution was read:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, in cooperation with Works Progress Administration, have, are and will be constructing storm sewers in the City of Idaho Falls,

AND, WHEREAS, it is the purpose of the storm sewers to segregate the storm water from sanitary sewage, to the end that the sanitary lines will not become overloaded and back up into basements.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that sanitary connections and roof drains from adjacent buildings be segregated and that storm water only be discharged into the storm sewer, and that all sanitary lines be connected to the sanitary sewer.

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

An ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS: DESCRIBING SAID LANDS, AND DECLARING THE SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS" was read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Fanning, that the ordinance be passed on its first reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Evans, that the rule of law requiring that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings be suspended and the ordinance be placed on its second and third readings. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the ordinance be passed on its second reading. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

The ordinance was again read in full by the Clerk. It was moved by Mehlhoff, seconded by Gourley, that the ordinance be passed on its third and final reading and be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Crabtree, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

The ordinance was then numbered 530 and passed to the Mayor for his approval, and was by him, the Mayor, duly signed and approved and ordered published in one issue of the Post-Register, the official newspaper of the City of Idaho Falls.

The following resolution was read:

"Whereas, Ordinance No. 530 was passed and approved on the 19th day of January, 1940, annexing certain land therein described to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, and it appearing that it is not necessary at this time to survey said land as provided by Sec. 49-304 Idaho Code Annotated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said land shall not be surveyed until the further order of the City Council by that the Clerk of the City of Idaho Falls shall duly certify to a copy of said Ordinance under the corporate seal of the City of Idaho Falls and immediately file said certified copy of said Ordinance with the County Recorder of Bonneville County, Idaho."

It was moved by Gourley, seconded by Wasley, that the resolution be adopted and approved. Roll call. Voting aye: Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree. Voting nay: Brandl. Motion carried.

Lease agreement between the Western Air Express and the City of Idaho Falls covering the rental of office and waiting room in the administration building at the airport was read. It was moved by Evans, seconded by Mehlhoff, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease agreement. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Sutton, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
