It was moved by Brandl, seconded by Fanning, that the licenses be granted. Roll call. Voting aye: Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

Lease agreement between Company "A" 116th Engineers, Idaho National Guard, and the City of Idaho Falls, was read. It was moved by Sutton, seconded by Brandl, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call. Voting aye: Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

Machine Lease Agreement between Westmont Tractor & Equipment Company and the City of Idaho Falls was read. It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Crabtree, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the lease. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Fanning, seconded by Gourley, that Sections of ordinance No. 485 be amended so that it will be mandatory for the registration of all bicycles with the Police Department, and that a permanent registration number be issued to each bicycle owner free, by the Police Department. Roll call. Voting aye: Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

After discussion, the following resolution was offered.

BE IT RESOLVED By the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that:

WHEREAS, the contract completion date for Contract #2, P. W. A. Docket Idaho 1254-F was September 12, 1939; and,

WHEREAS, on account of incorporating items in Change Order #11-2-3 into the project necessitates an extension of time for the completion of said contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, that an extension of time of 167 days be allowed D. J. Sweeney, Contractor, for the completion of his contract and that liquidated damages in connection with said contract be and are hereby waived for such period of extension of time for the reasons above stated and in the letter of request from the contractor.

It was moved by Wasley, seconded by Evans, that the Resolution be adopted. Roll call. Voting aye: Wasley, Evans, Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Mehlhoff, Gourley. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.

It was moved by Crabtree, seconded by Gourley, that the meeting adjourn. Roll call. Voting aye: Sutton, Crabtree, Brandl, Fanning, Gourley, Mehlhoff, Wasley, Evans. Voting nay: None. Motion carried.
